Statement of Reason



A speed limit review has undertaken on the A487 at Carnhedryn, St Davids. The review took into account the collision history, speed survey data and geometry of the road. The review concluded that the current speed limit be reduced to 40mph through the Hamlet of Carnhedryn.

The Pembrokeshire County Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of its powers under Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
2. This Order may be cited as "The County of Pembrokeshire (Various Roads, Carnhedryn, St Davids) (40 mph Speed Limit) Order 2023" and shall come into operation on the **th day of February Two thousand and Twenty Three.
