

St. Dogmaels to Poppit Sand improvements

Location: St. Dogmaels



- . This scheme looks to provide an off-road traffic free route running alongside the B4546 to Poppit Sands a distance of 1.8 miles. This is a very hazardous stretch of road, narrow with fast traffic, blind bends, blind summits and drivers can be driving into the sun not seeing walkers, cyclists or children. The speed of traffic with high hedges impairing forward visibility is far from ideal and makes the scheme a necessity in terms of safety and encouraging modal shift to sustainable independent travel.
- . It is, for many local residents and visitors, a very popular destination.
- . This initiative was first mooted in 2006 by the community and a local working party was set up in 2013. Further to this, an online petition (in February 2014) calling for PCC to provide a safe and accessible walking and cycling path from St Dogmaels to Poppit Sands was launched.
- . There is thus a lot of community support for the scheme which shows that once the route is in place it will lead to modal change.
