**a) General – all four licensing objectives (b, c, d and e) (please read guidance note 11)**

All new staff will be giving training in relation to the requirements of the Licensing Act 2003.  
Current staff will be given refresher training in relation to the Licensing Act 2003 on an annual basis.  
All training will be recorded.

**b) The prevention of crime and disorder**

CCTV system installed at premises, in ground floor and first floor licensed area as well as beer garden.  
The system must incorporate a means of transferring images from the hard drive to a format that can be played back on any Windows compatible computer.  
The system must be capable of recording and retaining 31 days of images before over-recording.  
Recording equipment must record date and time information as part of the image file, and the date/time must be accurate.  
All users must be fully trained in the operation of the system and be made aware of their general legal responsibilities.  
There must be a competent person present on the premises, capable of replay and export of recordings quickly onto a removable storage medium at all times when the premises are open to the public and produce a copy to the police or an officer of the local authority immediately.  
The system must be registered with the Information Commissioner.  
A list will be maintained of all persons that are authorised to sell alcohol at premises.

**d) The prevention of public nuisance**

Notices shall be displayed at front door requesting patrons to leave the premises and the area quietly and respect the needs of residents.  
Notices will be displayed in the rear door and the beer garden requesting patrons to respect the needs of residents and be aware of any noise nuisance.  
Noise levels monitored.  
No persons will be allowed in the external area after 2300 hours on any day, except for smoking where notice will be displayed to be aware of disturbing neighbours  
Rear exit door from premises closed at 2300 hours (except for access to smoking shelter).



**e) The protection of children from harm**

Any person attempting to purchase alcohol on premises and is believed to be under 21 years of age will be asked to produce a document bearing his/her name, photograph, date of birth and holographic mark or ultraviolet feature. If neither document is not produced of alcohol will be made.

Any person consuming alcohol on premises and is believed to be under 21 years of age will be asked to produce a document bearing his/her name, photograph, date of birth and holographic mark or ultraviolet feature. If that document is not produced the alcohol will be confiscated.

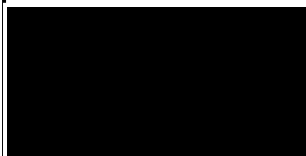

**This application cannot be used to vary the licence so as to extend the period for which the licence has effect or to vary substantially the premises to which it relates. If you wish to make that type of change to the premises licence, you should make a new premises licence application under section 17 of the Licensing Act 2003.**

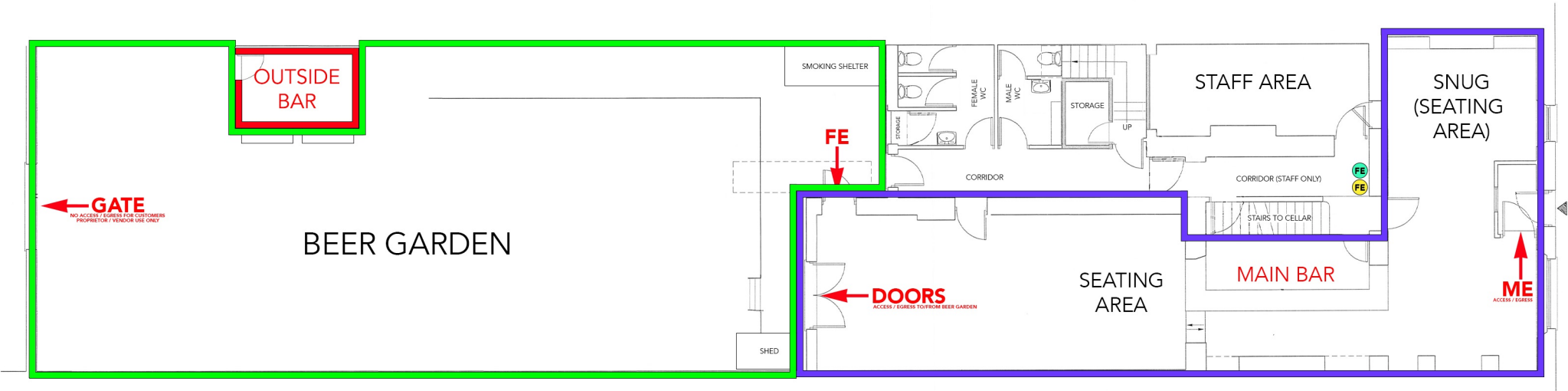
1. You do not have to pay a fee if the only purpose of the variation for which you are applying is to avoid becoming liable for the late night levy
2. Describe the premises. For example, the type of premises, its general situation and layout and any other information which could be relevant to the licensing objectives. Where your application includes off-supplies of alcohol and you intend to provide a place of consumption of these off-supplies of alcohol, you must include a description of where the place will be and its proximity to the premises.
3. In terms of specific regulated entertainments please note that:
  - Plays: no licence is required for performances between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
  - Films: no licence is required for 'not-for-profit' film exhibition held in community premises between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day provided that the audience does not exceed 500 and the organiser (a) gets consent to the screening from a person who is responsible for the premises; and (b) ensures that each such screening abides by age classification ratings.
  - Indoor sporting events: no licence is required for performances between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the audience does not exceed 1000.
  - Boxing or Wrestling Entertainment: no licence is required for a contest, exhibition or display of Greco-Roman wrestling, or freestyle wrestling between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the audience does not exceed 1000. Combined fighting sports – defined as a contest, exhibition or display which combines boxing or wrestling with one or more martial arts – are licensable as a boxing or wrestling entertainment rather than an indoor sporting event.
  - Live music: no licence permission is required for:
    - a performance of unamplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, on any premises.
    - a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day on premises authorised to sell alcohol for consumption on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
    - a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a workplace that is not licensed to sell alcohol on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.

- a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a church hall, village hall, community hall, or other similar community premises, that is not licensed by a premises licence to sell alcohol, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance from a person who is responsible for the premises.
    - a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, at the non-residential premises of (i) a local authority, or (ii) a school, or (iii) a hospital, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance on the relevant premises from: (i) the local authority concerned, or (ii) the school or (iii) the health care provider for the hospital.
  - Recorded Music: no licence permission is required for:
    - any playing of recorded music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day on premises authorised to sell alcohol for consumption on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
    - any playing of recorded music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a church hall, village hall, community hall, or other similar community premises, that is not licensed by a premises licence to sell alcohol, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance from a person who is responsible for the premises.
    - any playing of recorded music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, at the non-residential premises of (i) a local authority, or (ii) a school, or (iii) a hospital, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance on the relevant premises from: (i) the local authority concerned, or (ii) the school proprietor or (iii) the health care provider for the hospital.
  - Dance: no licence is required for performances between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the audience does not exceed 500. However, a performance which amounts to adult entertainment remains licensable.
  - Cross activity exemptions: no licence is required between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, with no limit on audience size for:
    - any entertainment taking place on the premises of the local authority where the entertainment is provided by or on behalf of the local authority;
    - any entertainment taking place on the hospital premises of the health care provider where the entertainment is provided by or on behalf of the health care provider;
    - any entertainment taking place on the premises of the school where the entertainment is provided by or on behalf of the school proprietor; and
    - any entertainment (excluding films and a boxing or wrestling entertainment) taking place at a travelling circus, provided that (a) it takes place within a moveable structure that accommodates the audience, and (b) that the travelling circus has not been located on the same site for more than 28 consecutive days.
