

There will be a limit of 20 people for licensed activity with the focus on providing an
enjoyable experience which complements the shop. For music and events it will be
ticket only and the license objectives match with those of the business.

## b) The prevention of crime and disorder

In the periods where alcohol is served to be consumed on the premises there will usually be two members of staff to allow suitable supervision of customers. The initially the aim of the shop is for appreciation and purchase of music rather than the consumption of alcohol.

#### c) Public safety

The premises (26 Market Street) has an electrical safety certificate and the power for the shop/venue is set up to demonstrate music and hifi equipment as part of normal trading already. There will be Risk Assessments carried out for specific events and first aid training will be provided to staff.

## d) The prevention of public nuisance

Limited hours of opening, with the hours in line or less than the immediate neighbours (The Georges and Seven Spice). The primary business will continue to be for the sale / resale of music and HiFi.

e) The protection of children from harm

Children will only be allowed during licensed activity, if accompanied by their								
parents. The business and premise owner is DBS checked.
