THE COUNTY OF PEMBROKE give notice that it intends to make the following Order under section 82, 83, 84 & 124 the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, as follows:

THE COUNTY OF PEMBROKE (VARIOUS ROADS) (SPEED LIMITS) AMALGAMATION ORDER 2023 (AMENDMENT NO.4) ORDER 2026

By amending The County of Pembroke (Various Roads) (Speed Limits) Amalgamation Order 2023, The effect of the proposals will be to:

- a) Introduce new, amend and/or revoke existing speed limits on those lengths of road listed in the Schedules to this notice.
- b) Replace all relevant Map Schedules with new revisions.

Statement of Reason

As part of the National Listening Programme, the Cabinet Secretary for Transport & North Wales invited feedback from residents, businesses, and all road users affected by the 20mph changes. Highway Authorities subsequently received a significant increase in correspondence, including requests both to revert certain roads to 30mph and to retain existing 20mph limits.

Following this engagement, the national guidance was formally updated in July 2024. This revised guidance provides a clearer framework for determining where a 20mph limit may appropriately revert to 30mph. Authorities were instructed to assess all feedback against the updated criteria and, where changes were considered appropriate, to progress them through the statutory Traffic Regulation Order (TRO) process.

Pembrokeshire is now in a position to commence the statutory consultation the process and the roads included in this order are presented in Schedule 1.

The County of Pembroke, in exercise of the powers under Sections 82, 83, 84 and 124 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended (“the Act”) and all other enabling powers, after consultation *inter alia* with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act hereby make the following order;

1. The County of Pembroke (Various Roads) (Speed Limits) Amalgamation Order 2023 shall be amended by the addition and revocation of the existing Schedules and hereby replaced, as set out in Schedule 1
2. The Order shall come into operation on ** ***** and may be cited as The County of Pembroke (Various Roads) (Speed Limits) Amalgamation Order 2024 (Amendment No.4) Order 2026.
3. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply to this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
4. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, The County of Pembroke (Various Roads) (Speed Limits) Amalgamation Order (Amendment No.4) Order 2026 shall have effect as though:

5. The remainder of the County of Pembroke (Various Roads) (Speed Limits) Amalgamation Order 2023 will remain in full force and effect.
