Examination into the Pembrokeshire Local Development Plan 2

Further to my introductory letter of 8 December 2025, I am writing to provide you with an update on the examination of the Pembrokeshire Local Development Plan (LDP) 2.

The Inspectors have called an exploratory meeting to discuss the potential impacts of the Plan on marine and riverine Special Areas of Conservation. This follows initial correspondence between the Inspectors and Pembrokeshire County Council, including a recent letter from the Inspectors outlining their concerns on this issue as it affects the soundness of the Plan. The exploratory meeting will be held at County Hall, Haverfordwest, SA61 1TP at **10.00 on Tuesday 16 June 2026**. The LDP examinations procedure guidance explains that an exploratory meeting should involve the local planning authority and Welsh Government. The Inspectors therefore request your participation in the meeting, which will be a structured discussion following an agenda to be published in advance on the Examination website. Natural Resources Wales have also been invited to participate in the meeting. No other participants are invited but the meeting will be open to all members of the public to observe.

Could you please confirm attendance by 5pm on Friday 29 May 2026 via the above email address. Please quote your representor ID reference, as shown above. If you are unable to attend in person, arrangements could be made for virtual participation. Please let me know your preference, including whether you wish to participate in Welsh.

The Inspectors will publish a note of the exploratory meeting and advise on the next steps of the LDP examination, soon afterwards. Please check the website for updates. Should you have any queries regarding the exploratory meeting, please let me know.
