Rhoddir hysbysiad yn unol ag adrannau 41 a 43 o Ddeddf Safonau a Threfniadaeth Ysgolion (Cymru) 2013 a'r Cod Trefniadaeth Ysgolion bod Cyngor Sir Penfro, ar ôl ymgynghori â'r personau hynny sy'n ofynnol, yn bwriadu gweithredu:

1. O 31 Rhagfyr 2026 ymlaen, cau Ysgol a Reolir yn Wirfoddol Cilgerran 3-11, SA43 2SB
2. O 1 Ionawr 2027 ymlaen, sefydlu Ysgol Gymunedol 3-11 ar safle'r ysgol bresennol, i'w chynnal gan Gyngor Sir Penfro. Categori iaith yr ysgol fydd Cyfrwng Cymraeg.

Fel y cynigydd, cynhaliodd Cyngor Sir Penfro gyfnod o ymgynghori cyn penderfynu cyhoeddi'r cynnig hwn. Ystyriwyd Adroddiad Ymgynghori sy'n cynnwys crynodeb o'r materion a godwyd gan ymgynghoreion, ymatebion y cynigydd a barn Estyn gan y Cyngor Sir ac mae ar gael ar wefan y Cyngor (www.sir-benfro.gov.uk/dweud-eich-dweud/ymgynghoriadau).

Fe fydd yr ysgol newydd arfaethedig yn Ysgol Gymunedol, a'r Awdurdod Derbyn fydd Cyngor Sir Penfro. Ni fydd gan yr ysgol newydd natur grefyddol ac ni fydd trefniadau derbyn ar gyfer yr ysgol newydd yn gwneud darpariaeth ar gyfer bandio disgyblion. Bydd y nifer derbyn ar gyfer pob grŵp oedran perthnasol ar gyfer yr ysgol newydd y bydd y cynigion yn cael eu gweithredu ynddi yn aros yr un fath fel a ganlyn;

Derbyn i Flwyddyn 6: 19

Capasiti disgyblion yr ysgol newydd fydd 133 o Ddisgyblion Llawn Amser a 13 o Ddisgyblion Meithrin (FTE). Bydd yr ysgol newydd yn cael ei chynnal ar safle presennol yr ysgol ar ôl gweithredu'r cynnig ac felly nid oes angen unrhyw ddarpariaeth arall. Ar ben hynny, yn amodol ar ddewis rhieni, bwriedir y bydd gan bob disgybl sy'n mynychu'r ysgol bresennol ar y dyddiad gweithredu le yn yr ysgol arfaethedig.

Bydd Cludiant o'r Cartref i'r Ysgol yn cael ei ddarparu yn unol â Pholisi Trafnidiaeth o'r Cartref i'r Ysgol yr Awdurdod ar ddyddiad gweithredu'r cynnig.

Mae gweithredu'r cynnig i roi'r gorau i ysgol WRh Cilgerran a sefydlu ysgol gymunedol 3-11 yn cael ei ystyried fel yr ymateb mwyaf priodol i fynd i'r afael â'r rhesymau a nodwyd wrth lunio'r cynnig mewn perthynas ag ansawdd tymor hwy a chynaliadwyedd

Notice is given in accordance with sections 41 and 43 of the School Standards and Organisation (Wales) Act 2013 and the School Organisation Code that Pembrokeshire County Council, having consulted such persons as required, proposes to implement:

3. As from 31 December 2026, discontinue Cilgerran 3-11 Voluntary Controlled School, SA43 2SB
4. As from 1 January 2027, establish a 3-11 Community School on the site of the existing school, to be maintained by Pembrokeshire County Council. The language category of the school will be Welsh Medium.

As proposer, Pembrokeshire County Council undertook a period of consultation before deciding to publish this proposal. A Consultation Report containing a summary of the issues raised by consultees, the proposer's responses and the views of Estyn was considered by the County Council and is available on Council's website (www.pembrokeshire.gov.uk/haveyoursay).

The proposed new school will be a Community School, and the Admission Authority will be Pembrokeshire County Council. The new school will not have a religious character and admissions arrangements for the new school will not make provision for pupil banding. The admission number for each relevant age group for the new school in which the proposals will be implemented will remain unchanged as follows;

Nursery: 13
Reception to Year 6: 19

The new school's pupil capacity will be 133 Full Time Pupils and 13 Nursery Pupils (FTE). The new school will be maintained on the existing school site following implementation of the proposal and therefore no alternative provision is necessary. Furthermore, subject to parental preference, it is intended that all pupils attending the current school as at the implementation date will have places in the proposed school.

Home to School Transport will be provided in accordance with the Authority's Home to School Transport Policy as at the date of the implementation of the proposal.

The implementation of the proposal to discontinue Cilgerran VC school and establish the same as a 3-11 Community school is seen as the most
