Penrhyn Church in Wales VC School

A £3.9 million new build 3-11 English medium primary school built on a new site in Hundleton to replace Stackpole VC, Angle VC and Orielton CP Schools. The new build will accommodate 120 learners plus an early years unit for 17 places and provision for a private playgroup that was relocated from Stackpole.

The main reasons and the advantages of the scheme were:

- ➤ to develop a new learning campus that met 21st Century School requirements with accommodation being flexible for current and future needs;
- ➤ to provide a larger campus which is better placed for providing a broader curriculum and extracurricular activities, the site also has provision for car parking and new grassed and MUGA pitches;
- > to provide pupils and staff with a purpose built facilities which will aid in improving standards;
- ➤ to provide the community with an early years unit for up to 17 children prior to them entering primary school;
- to provide a cost effective and efficient model for delivery, removing unnecessary duplication and aligning capacity with demand (in light of demographic change), generating economies of scale and expanding economies of scope;
- ➤ to improve the quality of primary school facilities within the area and provide a sustainable model of primary education provision on the Angle Peninsula;
- > to provide education in a building that is fit for purpose;

> the building provides provision for a private playgroup which was relocated from Stackpole.
