

FREE SCHOOL MEALS – Secondary



ARE YOU MISSING OUT on £2.70 for a free meal for your child every school day?

In order for the applicant to qualify for Free School Meals, either the parent / Legal Guardian or student themselves must be in receipt of either:

- ☺ Income Support
- ☺ Jobseekers Allowance, Income-based only (JSA) (Please note Contribution Based Jobseekers Allowance does not qualify - JSACB)
- ☺ Guarantee Element of State Pension Credit
- ☺ Child Tax Credits, with an Annual Household Income of under £16,190 p.a. (Please note Working Tax Credits does not qualify even if received in addition to these benefits.)*
- ☺ Income-Related Employment Support Allowance Only
- ☺ Support under part VI of the immigration and asylum Act 1999
- ☺ Working Tax Credit 'run on' - the payment someone may receive for a further 4 weeks after they stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- ☺ Universal Credit - where earned income does not exceed £7400

As a guide, your annual household income is usually stated on a TC602 Tax Credits Summary/Award Notice.

*You do not qualify if you receive Working Tax Credits and Child Tax Credits - even if your annual household income is still under £16,190p.a.
