

**THE COUNTY OF PEMBROKE (B4313 & ADJOINING ROADS AT BETHESDA)
(30MPH & 40MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2021**

NOTICE is hereby given that Pembrokeshire County Council propose to make an Order under Section 84 and part III of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"). The effect of the Order will be to impose a 30mph limit through the junction and village and provide a 40mph "buffer zone" speed limit between the 30mph and national speed limited as specified in the Schedule to this order.

The proposals are being promoted following a speed limit review through the village.

Statement of Reason

A speed limit review has been carried out on the B4313 through the village of Bethesda. The review took into account the accident history, speed survey data, geometry of the road, and other factors including extent of residential development and junction arrangement. The review concluded that the current limit should be reduced to 30mph through the bend, junction and adjoining U6100 & U6111 where there are residential properties and a 40mph buffer limit extending for 500metres to the north east past the outlying properties.



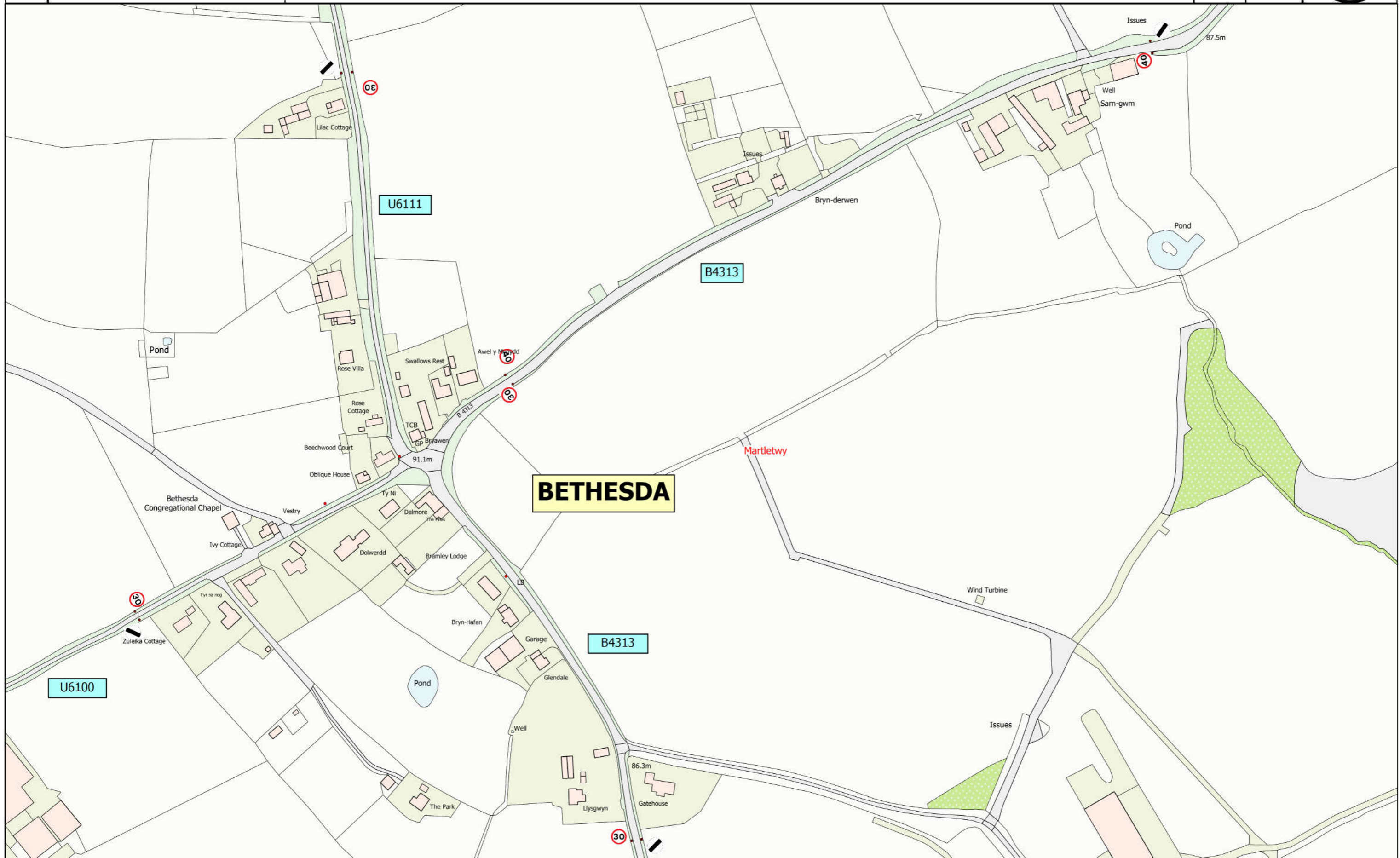
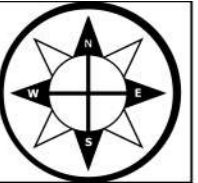
Proposed 30mph & 40mph Buffer limit B4313/U6111/U6100 - Bethesda

The Pembrokeshire County Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.
2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the lengths of road specified in the Schedule 2 to this Order.
3. This Order may be cited as "The County of Pembroke (B4313 & Adjoining Roads at Bethesda (30mph & 40 mph Speed Limit) Order 2021" and shall come into operation on the [REDACTED] Two Thousand and Twenty One.
