

**THE COUNTY OF PEMBROKE (VARIOUS ROADS, ST DOGMAELS)
(REVOCACTION) AND (20MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2021**



NOTICE is hereby given that Pembrokeshire County Council propose to make an Order under Sections 84 (1) & (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule to the Act of 1984, the effect of which will be to introduce a 20mph speed limit along those lengths of road contained in the Schedule to this notice.

'The County of Pembroke (Various Roads) (Restricted Roads & 30mph Speed Limit) Order 2017' will be revoked insofar as it relates to the lengths of road referred to in the schedule to this notice.

'The County of Pembroke (St Dogmaels) (Imposition of 20mph Speed limit) Order 2010' will be revoked as it relates to the lengths of road referred to in the schedule and will be consolidated within this order.

Statement of reason:

St Dogmaels currently benefits from a localised 20mph zone and 20mph limit on a number of roads: High Street, Feidr Fawr, Pilot Street & Maeshyfryd,

A request has since been received for the introduction of a 20mph speed limit through the whole village of St Dogmaels.

By introducing a 20mph speed limit which encompasses the built environment of St Dogmaels, the Council aims to reduce the number and severity of road accidents, increase safety for all residents and improve the quality of life for all communities, no matter which mode of transport they use.



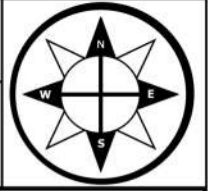
Proposed 20mph St Dogmaels - Consultation Plan

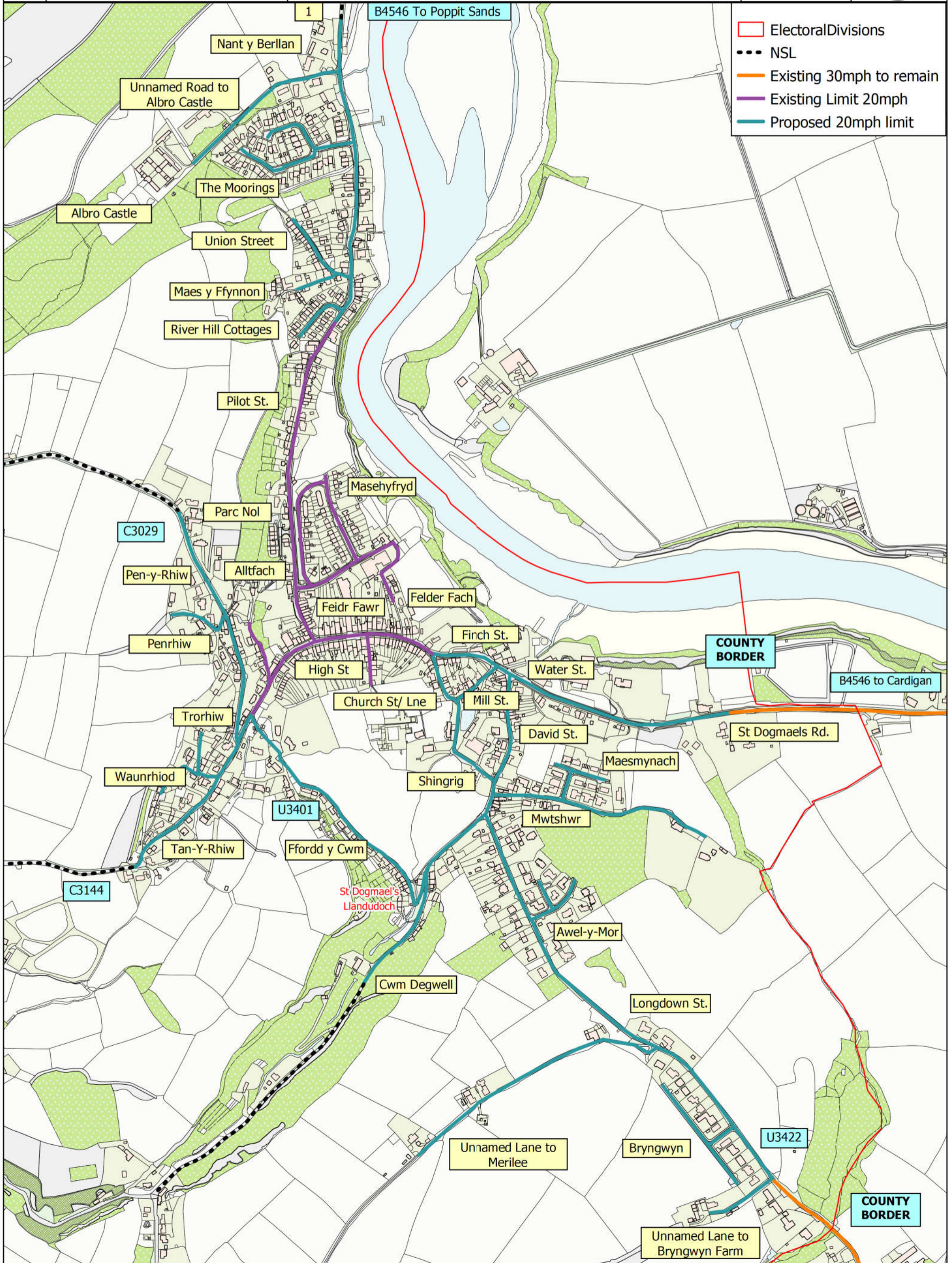

**THE COUNTY OF PEMBROKE (VARIOUS ROADS, ST DOGMAELS)
(REVOCATION) AND (20MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2021**

The Pembrokeshire County Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of its powers under Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour on the length of road set out in the Schedule.
2. This Order may be cited as 'The County of Pembroke (Various Roads, St Dogmaels) (Revocation) and (20mph Speed Limit) Order 2021 and shall come into operation on the xxx day of April Two Thousand and Twenty One.
3. 'The County of Pembroke (Various Roads) (Restricted Roads & 30mph Speed Limit) Order 2017' will be revoked insofar as it relates to the lengths of road referred to in the schedule to this notice.
4. 'The County of Pembroke (St Dogmaels) (Imposition of 20mph Speed limit) Order 2010' will be revoked as it relates to the lengths of road referred to in the schedule and will be consolidated within this order.
