The effect of the Order will be to impose a 40mph limit through the junction as specified in the Schedule to this order.

'The County of Pembroke (Freystrop) (Imposition of 50mph Speed limit) Order 2005' will be revoked, insofar as it relates to the lengths of road referred to in the schedule to this order.

## Statement of Reason

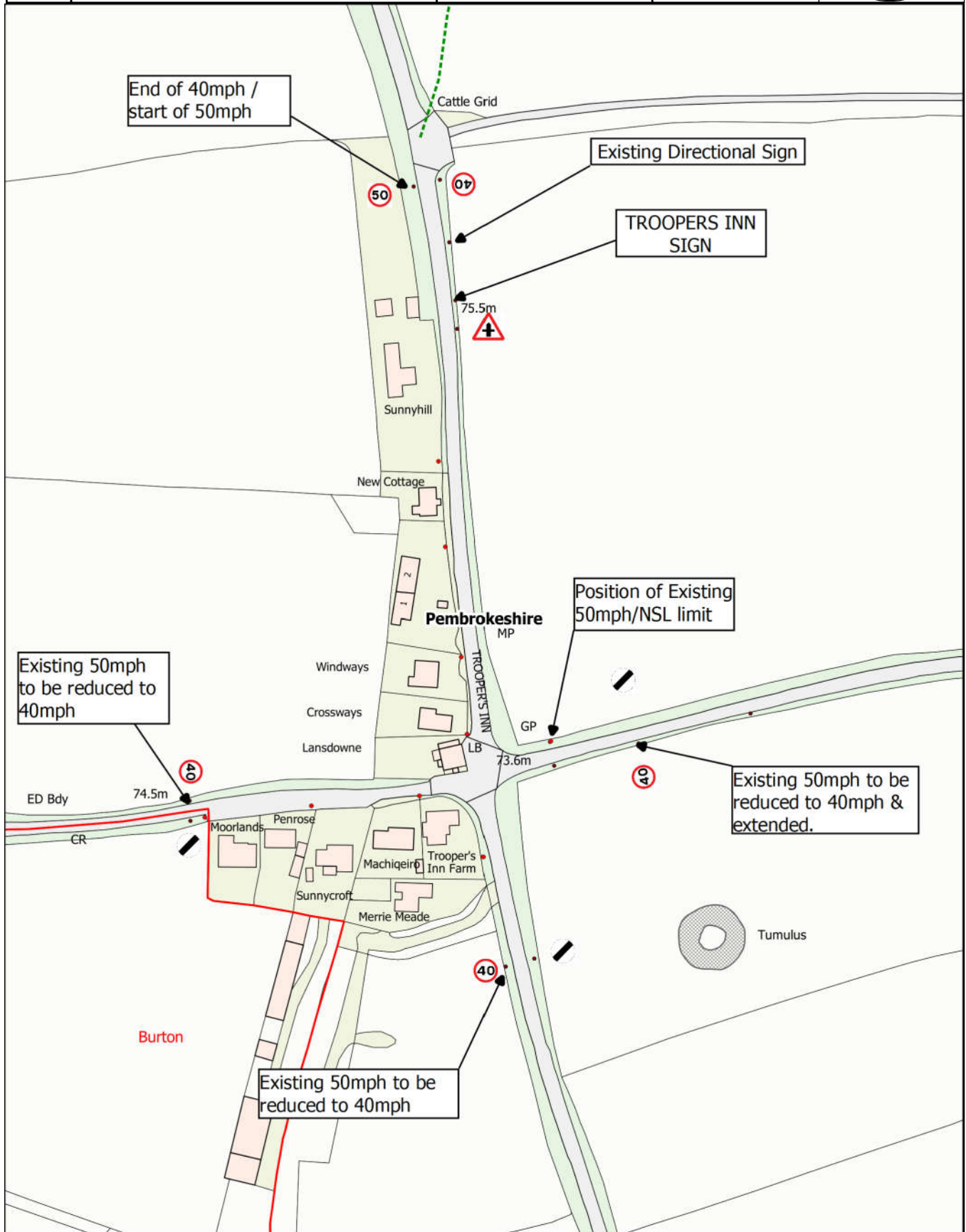
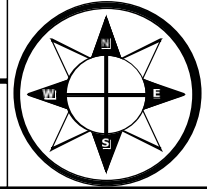
A speed limit review has been carried out on the C3007 at Trooper Inn. The review took into account the collision history, speed survey data and geometry of the road. The review concluded that the current speed limit should be reduced to 40mph through the junction.

The Pembrokeshire County Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of its powers under Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
2. 'The County of Pembroke (Freystrop) (Imposition of 50mph Speed limit) Order 2005' is hereby revoked, insofar as it relates to the lengths of road referred to in the schedule to this order.
3. This Order may be cited as "The County of Pembroke (Freystrop) (40 mph Speed Limit) Order 2021" and shall come into operation on the XX day of July Two thousand and Twenty One.
